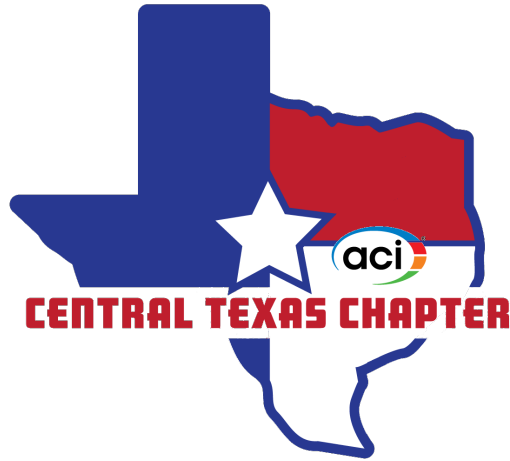




Professional Development Hours (PDH's)

ACI Chapter Talk: Long Lasting Concrete Slabs by Paul Laskey.

Paul presented on the keys to long lasting concrete slabs. Attendees were presented best practice guidelines based on current ACI standards and recommendations and personal experience.
